2. Nomination papers may be obtained during normal office hours, from the Returning Officer at the address shown below.
3. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 2nd May 2024**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 16th April 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by **5pm on Wednesday 17th April 2024**. Applications for postal voting can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Documents valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**. 7. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**. Applications for non-permanent proxy voting arrangements can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>. Applications for permanent proxy voting arrangements must be obtained from the Electoral Registration Officer.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy on grounds of occupation, service or employment, medical condition, or the loss, theft or destruction of photographic identification to be used at the polling station, arising after **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**, must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Thursday 2 May 2024**.
