When the Parish Councils were created in 1894 separating Church and local government, the annual parish meeting continued and has been confirmed by the Local Government Act 1972 as a forum for the electors of a parish to meet, discuss issues and pass resolutions. The Parish Meeting is convened by the Chair of the Parish Council or a group of electors between March and June each year. It is separate from the Parish Council.
