Comments provided to Planning: Petrockstowe PC wish to object to this application and have the following comments for consideration: 1. As this application is to replace an existing Class Q permission which specified that the project had to be complete by September 2021. If it is a ruse to extend the completion permission date then we oppose it. 2. The previous application gave much greater detail on the external appearance which we want to see in this application. 3. This application is lacking in detail regarding foul water treatment and discharge which needs further details as raised in the environmental officer's report. Also there is a stream running close by and downhill from the proposed dwelling. 4.We would like clarification on the materials to be used on the roof, which is currently described as either metal sheeting or lightweight tiles. There needs to be greater detail to enable an inspection to be completed and for that inspector to be able to know that the building is being built according to the granted permission. 5. There is little detail about the 'hut'. Is it for living

- quarters during construction? No mention of lavatory facilities during construction?
