

### **Plannina**

A recent application for change of use of paddock to 4 gypsy pitches and associated works in Violet Lane was refused by Basingstoke and Deane, and the DoE appeal inspector has agreed with their decision. A decision by Basingstoke on another application for a glamping site with 6 pods is currently awaited.

## **Play Areas**

Since appointing our new contractors we have been busy replacing worn and damaged items, and Improving the sites in terms of health and safety.

## **Heath End Hall extension**

The Mayor of Basingstoke and Deane opened the extension to Heath End Village Hall in Baughurst on 3 September 2017. The extension will enable Little Stars Pre-school to open for 30 hours per week in line with recent government requirements.

We will also be able to accommodate new groups in the Hall during the day, mainly for older people to reduce isolation and encourage the development of new skills.

The new room will be called the Jeffery Room, to recognise the energy and efforts of the current Chair, Ann Jeffery, who is standing down at the end of the year after 17 years service, and Tony Jeffery, who does most of the maintenance on the Hall on a voluntary basis and has managed the building work on behalf of the committee.

#### Bob O'Bee Memorial Clock

The clock sits in the apex of the Hall, having been purchased by public subscription in 1998, the year after Bob's death.

The new extension to the Hall meant the clock needed a clean and restoration, and we are indebted to Mr Christopher Eyre for volunteering to carry out the work , and for a superb job.

### Open spaces and trees

Both stages of the tree survey and remedial works have now been completed. These included all trees which required tree surgery on grounds of health and safety, according to an arboricultural surveyor.

Litter is an ongoing problem. Please report it to Basingstoke and Deane, or to the Clerk, and we will endeavour to have it cleared. Meanwhile, please take your litter home with you.

British Gas have now completed the re-laying new pipes in various areas of Baughurst. Following this, all areas should have been reinstated to their original state, as near as possible – do let us know if this has not happened.

## **Flytipping**

We anticipate an increase in flytipping locally, as residents cannot easily access a nearby waste facility. Please report all flytipping in the first instance to 01256 844844, Basingstoke and Deane Environmental Services.

#### Traffic courtesy

Is there anyone else out there who wishes that we had a local 'code' for the navigation of our various 'pinch points' in the parish? Too often a driver can let one person go through, only to be followed by two or three more who whizz through without waiting to be beckoned on. Could we not try and follow a 'one on one' code?

**Baughurst Community Speedwatch** has been active throughout the year on the busiest roads within the 30 mph speed limits. Between March and mid-September details of 224 motorists have been passed to the Police for action – including drivers of large lorries and a school bus. Six of these motorists have received Police visits in response to their excessive speed with some caught driving in excess of 50 mph.

Speedwatch volunteers are often told by local residents that they are too scared to walk or cycle on the local roads where there are no pavements. Given that the risk of death if hit by a vehicle doubles as the vehicle speed increases from 30 to 40mph it is clear that local road safety can be significantly improved by driving within the speed limit and at speeds appropriate to the conditions.

Penalties for speeding changed in April this year and now reflect the income of the driver, with fines up to £1000 possible for a serious first offence. Our rural roads around Baughurst have many particularly vulnerable road users. In 2015, 51% of all road deaths in the UK occurred on rural roads. Please slow down and drive carefully. It only takes a few drivers to slow down to help reduce the speed of many more and reduce nuisance and improve safety for us all.
