



LOWDHAM VILLAGE HALL
DIAMOND JUBILEE 200 CLUB

RULES

1. The object of the Club is to raise funds for the Village Hall.
2. The Club will be run under the supervision of the Committee who will also administer the Club.
3. The Club is open to all. Members must be over 16 years of age. Members must fill in an application form.
4. The fee for each number will be paid annually in advance. Members may have more than one number. Cheques should be made payable to Lowdham Village Hall.
5. Subscriptions by cash will be accepted on the basis of a maximum period of twelve months (£12 per number).
6. New members will be admitted when numbers become available. A waiting list will be kept and numbers will be offered to the first person on the list.
7. A monthly draw will take place at Committee Meetings (held once a month in the Village Hall).
8. The regular monthly prize money will be 50% of the monthly income - there will be three prizes:-

1 st prize	=	25% of monthly prize fund
2 nd prize	=	15% of monthly prize fund
3 rd prize	=	10% of monthly prize fund
9. The relevant numbers of all paid up members will be entered in the draw for each month. All subscriptions need to be paid within seven days of that month's draw.
10. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
11. The winners will be advised by telephone or email (as applicable) as soon as practicable after the draw has taken place.
12. The results will be published in the Parish Magazine and on the Village Hall website.
13. All prize money will be paid out by cheque.
14. The total income collected will be split 50% towards prize money and 50% to Village Hall funds.
15. In any matter requiring adjudication, the decision of Lowdham Village Hall and Playing Fields Committee will be final. The Committee shall also have the power to revoke these rules at their discretion and will provide reasonable notice to the members where necessary.
16. The Diamond Jubilee 200 Club will be formally registered with Newark and Sherwood District Council in accordance with the Gambling Act 2005.
