Reasons/Comments	Members wished the development to go ahead because it will provide much-needed affordable accommodation in the village.
	They were, however, unhappy about the height (9m) of the redeveloped properties, especially compared with those opposite; there was also concern about the high density of housing – both of these will adversely affect the existing village street scene.

10/02548/FULMAJ Reasons/Comments (Continued)	Parking - which is already a problem with 26 garages on site, although not all of them used for parking cars - remains a major concern. Councillors acknowledge the efforts by Sovereign to address this issue through the commissioning of a Transport Study
	and endorse the recommendations in the Report that Sovereign should provide dropped kerb crossings for some existing residents and extend the parking bays in Hampstead Norreys Road.
	They believe that more parking spaces should be provided and this could be achieved through the use of a herringbone parking pattern, in preference to the proposed parking of cars perpendicular to the properties.
