This is our last chance. Your email addresses are essential. In the last update in the October

issue of the magazine we reported that an Open Market Review was being undertaken by

Surrey County Council as the only way to establish a clear understanding of the latest

position regarding existing and planned broadband coverage throughout the county. The

review will identify all premises throughout Surrey without a fibre broadband connection or

those covered by the fibre network but unable to access the service as in Mickleham. Once

the findings of the OMR have been analysed this information will then form part of a public

consultation process. We are now approaching the end of this review and the start of the

Public Consultation. We are still awaiting confirmation of this date. However as a

community we must be ready to respond to this Public Consultation and be in a position to

make a very strong case for Mickleham to be connected to Superfast Broadband. We must

be top of the list!

The following is a quote from the BBC news website which appeared on Saturday 7th

November 'Government plans 'universal service obligation' to ensure people living in remote

areas guaranteed at least 10 Mbps'. Currently we are lucky to get up to 2 Mbps. Also

Mickleham is not seen as a 'remote' area and we could possibly be excluded from this

Government's 'universal service obligation'. This makes it even more important that we

respond to the Public Consultation.

Secondly, Mole Valley District Council has issued an Infrastructure Needs Assessment asking

We need to get broadband at the top of this list.
