281. Finances.

- 281.1. Payments approved as per the Notice of Essential Business approved.
- 281.2. Council approved the half yearly Accounts statement
- 281.3. Council approved the Precept demand for 2021-2022

282. Planning.

282.1. Council confirmed decisions made on Planning since the last meeting. (see Notice of Business for details)

283. Project Updates

- 283.1. SCC Rights of Way are waiting for approval from Natural England for the work on Rock Lane. Cllr Waygood has offered to do the work but cannot start until SCC ROW authorise the work.
- 283.2. Kings Estates have agreed to look at the dangerous tree on the Avenue in Triscombe.
- 283.3. Council is waiting for a response from Kings Estates re the offer to gran some money towards the construction of the car park.
- 283.4. The Rising Sun has been added to the Assets of Community Value register. Council welcomed the news that potential new buyers have expressed their hope to re-open the Rising Sun if their purchase completes.
- 283.5. Work continues on the Fibre Broadband project. Enough pledges have been received and Openreach have started work on the project. The team are looking at forming a Community Interest Company to manage the project/contract and may seek a grant from Council towards the cost of setting that up.
- 283.6. A gate will be fitted across the lane to Triscombe Stone but it will not be locked. Warning/prohibition to traffic signs to be erected.
- 283.7. No progress on the Playpark. The cost of bark has risen greatly over the past couple of years which makes it expensive to renew it only to be blown away within a year or two. Further costings on alternatives to be sought.

284. Date of Next Meeting.

The next full meeting is due on 21st January 2020. If COVID restrictions prevent a public meeting then a Notice of Essential Business will be issued.
