15/01	<b>Confirm and approve the minutes of last Annual Parish Assembly on 14th April 2014</b> – minutes were confirmed. Proposed JH. Seconded BA. Signed DW.	
15/02	<b>Matters arising – update – INFO ONLY –</b> 14/04 – TS confirmed that availability of free red parking spaces in Hook car parks would be down to Hook Parish Council, but would thoroughly recommend them as they increase usage of the village's facilities. 14/07 – AK confirmed that Mattingley Parish is scheduled for a hub upgrade in August 2015 by BT, which will hopefully solve the lack of broadband reception.	
15/03	<b>General update on County Council matters by County Councillor David Simpson</b> – a report was read out by DS. Councillors raised concerns over long periods of time that roads are closed for to allow road repairs and the long diversions created. DS confirmed that by closing a road allows the works to be completed quicker & if an A road is closed then the diversion has to be via an A road and not B roads or unclassified roads. Councillors also raised pot hole repairs appear to be causing further pot holes to appear around the finished repair. DS confirmed that temporary repairs are assessed on a random basis for quality of work.

15/04	<p><b>General update on District Council matters by District Councillor Tim Southern</b> – TS reported that the first stage of the new roundabout near Blackbush Airport is nearing completion &amp; commends the contractor on the good organisation of the works. TS also reported that the Local Plan is on schedule to be produced by Hart DC by the end of the year, however, he, personally, is not in favour of the Winchfield Development as the location is not suitable and there are other brownfield sites that are more suitable. Planning processes for a new Leisure Centre in Fleet have been passed and now await agreement for funding. Completion of the new centre is expected within the next 2-3 years. Ken Crookes resigned as Leader of Hart DC on points of principle and has taken over the portfolio of financial matters and the Leisure Centre.</p> <p>TS also confirmed that the collection schedules of bins have been re-organised and hopefully missed bins are no longer occurring. TS also raised concerns of 2 entry lanes on the Swallowfield roundabout reducing to 1 exit lane causing accidents. TS suggested if lane markings making 1 lane left turn only towards Wellington Country Park might alleviate the problem.</p> <p>TS then read out a report provided by D.Cllr Anne Crampton. Councillors raised and discussed speed limit measures around the local area.</p>	<p><b>PCCW</b> – to look into possibility on lane marking.</p>
15/05	<p><b>Chairman's Report by Councillor Doug Wheeler</b> – a report was read out by DW.</p> <p>No questions were raised.</p>	
15/06	<p><b>Financial Report by Parish Clerk Joanna Waland-Hadley</b> – a report was read out by JWH.</p> <p>No questions were raised.</p>	
15/07	<p><b>Other Parish Matters - An opportunity for all Parishioners to raise any concerns</b> – PCCW introduced herself as the new Police person for the local area and will be making herself known throughout the Parish to the local residents.</p> <p>No other questions were raised.</p>
