Notes On Membership

New Bowlers:- We will ask you to undertake a training program by attending our coaching sessions – typically three sessions is sufficient.

Experienced bowlers:- We may ask you to meet with a committee member and/or to assess your bowling action before confirming membership.

A copy of the Club Constitution and Rules is available for download on our Club website www.millbowlingclub-ruislip.co.uk (under Members Info).

Members are expected to make themselves familiar with, and abide by, the club rules.

Copies of club competition rules can be obtained from the Competition Secretary.

The successful operation of the club relies on members volunteering their time where possible. Some activities are managed through a rota and it is expected that members will undertake their allocated duties.

Members will be required to undertake tea duties and this is typically one match per season.

Green Ranger duties on match days will be allocated to one of the selected players. Training will be given.

Friendly matches are the lifeblood of the club and all members are encouraged to make themselves available for selection whenever possible.

Selection of teams for external club competitions would normally be made from existing members. New members may indicate their willingness to play in these fixtures but should be aware that first-year members are not normally considered for these matches.

The club runs a series of social events throughout the year. These include bingo nights, quiz nights, race nights and a Christmas party.

During the closed season, the club has a Short Mat Bowls session each Monday and Wednesday evening starting at 6.00 pm. Cost:- £1.00 per session.

The attendance of members at these events helps to raise funds for the club but also provides an opportunity to socialise with fellow members. These events are open to family and friends.

We hope that new members will enjoy and support these events.
