**Present**: Councillors. R Burnham (Chairman), A Fellowes, A Price, J Wills, P Booker, C Kemsley-Pein, District/County Councillor Cecile Irving-Swift, District Councillor Richard Auger

**Attendees :** 1 member of the public was present.

**16/46. Apologies : -** M Ward, H Weston

**16/47 Declarations of Interests: -** None declared. Later in the meeting P Booker declared in relation to the Rural Exception Scheme in relation to DDC.

16/48. Comments from the public: - A member of the public asked if more publicity could be given to the superfast broadband survey being carried out by NCC. Currently Clipston is excluded from the next roll-out and lobbying of NCC needs to take place if Clipston are to be included. ACTION: Cllr Wills to draft an article to include in the next edition of the Clipston Courier and publicise via Facebook. ACTION: Clerk to e mail Cecile Irving-Swift to express Parish Council's view that Clipston should be included.

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Cecile Irving-Swift and Richard Auger updated the Council as follows: -

- 1. There will be a change of policy in relation to refuse collection in two year's time. The Council will be moving to the 123 system which has been publicised. Any feedback can still be given to DDC.
- 2. Welford has completed their first draft of a Neighbourhood Plan. Other villages should be encouraged to complete their Plans. It was noted Clipston has an open meeting to be held on the 15<sup>th</sup> September to discuss the draft.
- 3. DDC are promoting Grants which are being given to assist people with disabilities to remain in their own homes.
- 4. The Parish Council should ensure that a clear reason is given when responding to planning applications i.e. For or Against.
- **5.** A grant may be available from DDC in relation to the Christmas Tree Festival. **ACTION : Clerk to contact Tim Cantwell at DDC.**
- 6. The Wormslade Planning Application for the Anaerobic Digester Plant has been granted which is disappointing as all of the parishes objected to this application.
- 7. The cost of Adult and Child care is still the largest expenditure of NCC.
- 8. Cllr Irving-Swift met with NCC who examined the roads and stated the potholes which had been raised as a concerns for cyclists were not within the criteria for repair.
- 9. Clir Burnham raised concerns regarding the number of major road signs which are now not visible due to overgrown vegetation. ACTION: Clerk to contact Cecile regarding this and the overgrown vegetation in Clipston which has been reported but not actioned for some months.
- 10. If there are any sites in the village which can be utilised for Rural Affordable Housing
