For information:

All Parish Councils in England are required by law to hold an Annual Parish Meeting, which must take place between 1st March and 1st June (inclusive).

The purpose of the meeting is for the Parish Council to explain what it has been doing over the last year and enables electors to have their say on things they consider to be of importance to the people of the Parish.

Who can attend the meeting?

The Annual Parish Meeting is a meeting of all the local government electors of the Parish. It is **not** a meeting of the Parish Council but is usually hosted by the Parish Council. Anyone can attend but only registered electors of Ninfield Parish may speak or vote any action requiring a vote.
