Notice of closure of **Footpathh BW-630**, **Bewdley**, Worcestershire ("the highway") as an **Emergency Measure**.

It appears to Worcestershire County Council that because of the likelihood of danger to the public as a result of a fallen tree, therefore there is an urgent need to close the highway immediately in the following terms: -

- 1. The effect of the Notice is that no person shall proceed along Footpath BW-630, Bewdley for its entire length.
- 2. This provision shall continue in force for a maximum of 21 days (unless further provision is made for its continuance). It is anticipated that it will remain in force for 21 days.
- 3 No alternative route available.

Nothing in this Notice shall prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the highway, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from and only from the highway.
