<u>The Accumulator</u> - started on 11 May and is a <u>monthly</u> competition for *all* levels of players. It's handicapped so that broadly Division 1 players will begin on scratch, Division 2 players start with 2 points, Division 3 players on 3 points and Division 5 and social bowlers on 4 points. Entrants each month will be drawn into groups of 4 and

play each of the other members of the group in a round robin, starting with their handicap points on the cards and play to the first to 13 points each time. Group winners will then receive 25 points for The Accumulator based on their aggregate score 2<sup>nd</sup> players 15, 3<sup>rd</sup> players 10 and 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> will receive 5. This means if you enter you will get a minimum of 5 points and a minimum of 3 games on the day against all standards. This helps to improve everybody's game too! Don't worry if all that looks complicated – you won't have to work it out, just play! It won't matter if you have to miss one, all it means is that you won't score that week. At the end of the season there will be a finals day when the top half of the scorers will play one knockout competition and the lower half play in another. Do give it a go. It's a sociable format as well. All members are welcomePhil's Trophy and Thelma's Cup will be played during weeks when there is no Accumulator. More details to follow.

## League News -

MSBL League chairman Sean Round made an impassioned plea to delegates for better behaviour at matches at the July Executive meeting. He referenced reports received of bad language, bad behaviour and fixture issues which had overshadowed what had been a good start to the season with fine bowling weather and lots of successes. He also stressed that bowlers need to use the right channels to express their concerns and that is via their Club Secretary.

Bowlers need to be aware of their surroundings, especially when playing in matches with juniors, and be mindful of the League's Code of Conduct. Bowlers, Clubs and the League have a duty of care to everyone. His sentiments were echoed by General Secretary Malcolm Fletcher in his report.

League Officers have been plagued by behaviour issues and fixture gripes on an almost weekly basis with an increasing number of individual bowlers contacting officers directly and at any time of the day! There is a right and proper way to bring matters to the attention of the League so that they can try to deal with them, and that is via Club Secretaries! Note that an official submission of complaint from a club has to be accompanied by a cheque for £50 to try to prevent frivolous complaints which should be dealt with initially by the Captains before they escalate an unresolved problem up to the Secretary.

Due to the date of the dinner being brought forward to November, making the time the organise things very short, there are a number of vital changes for bowlers to be aware of.

Normally, as per league rules, all member clubs are allocated and charged for 2 places at the presentation. This year, clubs NOT requiring those places will NOT be charged for them – as long as they inform dinner organisers Malcolm & Marg Fletcher immediately. Clubs will be billed for places that are booked via their end of season account

These changes are because we are limited to 140 people, are anticipating renewed interest in the revamped event at a new venue and with live entertainment and we have to finalise numbers and menu choices a month in advance of it, i.e. 14<sup>th</sup> October – and also pay in full for it!
