Intelligence 1 Q

- How can Chideock Parish Council and the Local Community help DVSA target what appears to be non-compliant Operators?

- Are Tankers specifically targeted?

Intelligence 1 A

- Our Intelligence Gathering helps us to Target and Plan our Enforcement work more Strategically
General 0300 123 9000 Anon 0800 030 4103
intelligence@dvsa.gov.uk
- Intelligence from both inside and outside GB help DVSA produce an Operator Target list which is updated regularly, this is Official/Sensitive information
- Target OPERATORS, not vehicle types, are Specifically Targeted, but we do conduct extra checks on Tankers carrying Hazardous Loads (Hazchem)

- Is DVSA aware of problems with HGVs being unable to ascend Chideock Hill Westbound and sometimes requiring several attempts?

- Local staff would be aware of this
- Local staff may have seen this
- By checking for Overweight and/or maybe by checking Emissions – but there could be other Reasons – engine fault
- A heavy articulated combination of a two axle unit pulling a three axle trailer; we'd probably find the drive axle of the unit overweight

Information 2 Q

- Chideock Parish Council appreciates the sensitivity of individual data.
- Could DVSA therefore provide a summary quarter by quarter of Operators who have HGVs passing through Chideock and have been inspected?
- A rough idea of how many vehicles/ journeys were involved would be appreciated.

Information 2 A

- There is a lot of sensitivity over individual data
- Because of problems with our DVSA site at Puddletown, there has been fewer checks there this year ('17-'18) than normal, however it should be ready to use again early '18-'19 - and we have recently been able to get the service area at Eype H&S RA'd
- Our last check there, 11 vehicles inspected (10 GB, 1 non-GB) 4 mechanical prohibitions issued = 36.36% prohibition rate. Puddletown info next;

Information 3 A

- Currently for the A35 between Bere Regis & Honiton we only have the Service area at Eype available to us for roadside inspections using our Mobile Stopping and Roadcheck vehicles
- When completed, our facility at Puddletown will also be available to us again using Mobile Stopping and Roadcheck & new Welfare vehicles as well as Mobile Weighpads, this will enhance the deterrent against the non-compliant Vehicles, Drivers & Operators
