11	21/05/23	Police action on exhaust noise from motorcycles	Request	Out	Police & Crime Commissioner	<p>"At the meeting with you on 22 June 2022 Chideock Parish Council asked the following question: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Construction and Use regulations are not being implemented. It is against the law to modify an exhaust thereby producing an increase in noise. It doesn't need technology to clamp down on this.</li> </ul> <p>You responded: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dorset Police do stop noisy motor bikes if they see / hear them.</li> <li>- Specific "stop" exercises must be conducted at a suitable location.</li> </ul> <p>You then agreed to investigate the idea of a "deterrent day" targeting this.</p> <p>You also said that Dorset Road Safe is investigating the use of "audio cameras" and that you would suggest to Grant Shapps (DfT) that a pilot is conducted in Dorset.</p> <p>Noisy motorcycles speed on Chideock Hill, and through the village once past the cameras, especially at weekends and on Bank Holidays.</p> <p>Chideock councillors request a progress update on these actions.</p> <p>Also, the Parish Council would like to arrange a meeting with you in the next couple of months.</p>

<b>19</b>		Chieock Flow Meter Rent Increase	Request	Out	Environment Agency	<p>"EA has a flow measuring site at Foss Orchard, Chideock.</p> <p>There is a 21-year lease with Chideock Parish Council, which owns the land, and an annual rent is paid to the council.</p> <p>The lease was renewed in 2013 and contains a clause stating that the rent is increased every 5 years in line with the Retail Price Index.</p> <p>The rent was increased in 2018 and is due for review this year.</p> <p>I have already received a cheque for £140, which is the amount agreed under the 2018 review.</p> <p>I assume that a cheque for the difference will be sent once the review has taken place.</p> <p>I attach a copy of the lease (prior to signing), a map of the location, and a copy of the 2018 letter confirming the increase.</p>
