Good News:

PC Jenny Groome attended Ogbourne CE Primary on June 7th to deliver talks to the KS1 and KS2 pupils -

People Who help us / Keeping Safe – Key Stage 1 (KS1) Ages 4-5

Personal and Online Safety – Key Stage 2 (KS2) Ages 9-10

Speed enforcement session was carried out this morning (6th July) at Ogbourne St Andrew and twelve vehicles were issued with notices of intended prosecution for excessive speeding.

The road monitored is a 30 MPH and the fastest vehicle was captured at 43 MPH

Depending on previous convictions and history,

- *11 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course,*
- *1 driver will be given £100 fine and receive 3 penalty points.*

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place,

which includes checking for MOT, Insurance & Point Totters and captured footage will be analysed for other offences like seat belts and mobile phone use.
