86.21 Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Councillor Sartain. The reason given was accepted by the Council.

87.21 Disclosable Pecuniary Interests

- a) No disclosable pecuniary interests were declared
- b) There were no applications for a dispensation regarding disclosable pecuniary interests
- **88.21 Public Participation Session** a period of 15 minutes will be set aside for the public to speak, with a strict 5-minute limit per speaker. Members of the public may speak on matters appearing on the agenda. However, if a matter does not appear on the agenda, a written request should be submitted to the Clerk no later than 2 working days before the meeting.

Ray Adams and Clive Leworthy from Airband and Ben Walker from Shropshire Council kindly attended the meeting to provide an update on the fibre broadband installation in the parish.

- Last section planned to be installed early part of next week (week commencing 24/01/22)
- The fibre cabinet has been relocated to public land on the main road by the lay-by
- Electricity is being installed to the cabinet on 01/02/22
- Airband electricians will connect it all up on 02/02/22
- OpenReach are coming with their engineering team to both install their connector and commission it on 03/02/22. Airband engineers will then commission it straight afterwards.
- The network can then be tested once it's live. Any remedial work will then be carried out.
- Handed over to the sales team to book in installations from 11/02/22

Following the update, the Chairman thanked the three gentlemen for their time and they left the meeting.

89.21 To approve the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 18 November 2021

The minutes of the previous meeting had been circulated.

resolved (without opposition)

that the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 18 November 2021 be accepted as a true record. The minutes were signed accordingly.

90.21 Matters arising from the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting of 18 November 2021

- a) Speeding on the A458 Clerk has written to David Waller advising of the outcome of investigations made by the Parish Council into the matter. Letter of thanks written to the Traffic Engineer at Shropshire Council for the comprehensive information received.
- b) Environmental Maintenance Contract advertised on website. Tenders to be discussed at 102.21 on agenda.

91.21 To receive report from Shropshire Councillor and/or Safer Neighbourhood Team (West Mercia Police)

Nobody from the SNT was able to attend.

Councillor Wild reported the following:

a) Cound Arbour Bridge – she has been chasing Gurnek Singh (Engineering Services & Bridges Manager, Shropshire Council) and can now advise that in conjunction with WSP they have put together all the diagrams, drawings and pictures they need and the signage has been worked out. Councillor Wild recommended inviting Mr Singh to the next meeting so that he can present the scheme which has been developed.

ACTION: Clerk to invite Mr Singh to March's meeting.

b) Recycling Bins – following requests from residents, and to improve recycling rates, a free wheelie bin will soon be available to households for the disposal of cans, glass and plastic. These will (optionally) replace the existing black recycling boxes, reduce the amount of waste being blown out of the boxes on windy days, make the storing of recycling more convenient for residents and will reduce the amount of bending and lifting for both residents and the waste removal crews. Register for a bin online at https://shropshire.gov.uk/requestmixedrecyclingbin. The rollout is commencing in April in Bridgnorth and delivery to Cound could potentially be that month.

92.21 To receive the defibrillator audit check for the period

Councillor Roberts had performed the audit checks for the period up to 14 January 2022 and confirmed that the defibrillators were ready to use as and when required.

93.21 To receive Clerk's Report

The Clerk reported that:

At a recent Clerks' Networking Meeting, it had been reported that a county parish council
have recently been conducting their meetings via Zoom. This is not permissible as there is

no legislation to permit it.

- Had written to parishioner re Parish Council's position on reducing the speed limit on the A458 within parish boundary.
- Had written a letter of thanks to Senior Traffic Engineer at Shropshire Council for guidance on possibility of reducing the speed limit on the A458 through the parish.
- The Planning Inspectorate has written to Shropshire Council asking for an update on the
 processing of our application for the Church Lane Definitive Map Moderation Order (to be
 received by 21 January 2022) to allow them to consider our appeal.

The precept had not been increased since the 2018/19 financial year and it was recognised by all that the precept could not remain at the previous level.

resolved by a majority vote (7 votes to 1)

that the precept for 2022/23 be set at £6,756.
