B2162 Hampstead Lane, Yalding
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2023

To allow structure works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2162 Hampstead Lane, Yalding.

A closure is planned from 13th February 2023, with estimated completion by 17th March 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (SV01471902629-01 - Environment Agency). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Hampstead Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while structure works are undertaken by Environment Agency.

The alternative route is via B2162 Hampstead Lane, Maidstone Road, A228 Boyle Way, A228 Branbridges Road, Beltring Road, Gravelly Ways, Lees Road and vice versa.
