B1122 Middleton Road Temporary Road Closure

Dear Resident,

Following on from my previous letter, I am writing to update you on the commencement of works near your property.

These works are part of the community road improvements scheme, on which we have closely consulted with your local parish council.

The works scheduled includes: tidying vegetation, sign installation, white lining and high friction surfacing improvements to the B1122 road and road junctions.

The B1122 road will be closed on weeknights (Monday to Thursday nights), from 7pm to 5am, as per the dates provided in the table below.

Details of works and duration are outlined below. Please note that dates may be subject to change and further updates will be issued on the works tracker at www.szcworkstracker.co.uk if changes occur.

There will be a diversion in place and access to property will be maintained during the temporary closure. The diversion route is as follows:

B1122, B1069, A1094, A12, and vice versa.
