Planning Application - PAP/2025/0335

Proposed Housing Development at Trent View Farm Mancetter Road Hartshill Nuneaton

- 1 Councillors are concerned over the location of the proposed junction leading into development which is on a bend. The proposed junction is also **too close to an existing junction Berrington** Road, raising the likelihood of **conflicting traffic movements**, driver confusion, and vehicle queuing. The short distance between the two junctions fails to allow safe separation and could lead to a **backlog of traffic**, increased turning conflicts, and reduced driver awareness of vehicles entering or exiting both junctions simultaneously.
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- 3 The site in question appears to contain, or be adjacent to, habitats that are likely to support a range of protected species, such as bats, badgers, red-kites, along with deer, foxes and rabbits:

We can see no **clear evidence** that full species-specific surveys have been conducted. Is it possible to **demonstrate how biodiversity net gain will be achieved?** as required under the current planning policy and the Environment Act. Without a full ecological survey, it is impossible to accurately assess the full environmental impact of this development or to implement adequate mitigation measures.

Along with this, the application does not specify whether:

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- The number of stories in each dwelling, the proposed density or mix of housing.

Report from Margaret Bell

Traffic calming measures were installed over the summer and have been met with mixed reviews. Any issues or complaints have been referred to County Councillor Jennifer Warren.

New crossing outside MDJS.

Arrests have been made on traveller site. Lot of anti-social behaviour reported on Clock Bridge.

Proposed development on Mancetter Rd (Trent Farm) Highways yet to respond. Cllrs advised that loss of a view is not a viable objection.

Damage to the wall of Hartshill Castle taken place over summer.

Rebecca Dyde would like to meet with council to discuss a talk on Hartshill Castle.

Atherstone Leisure Centre closed for health and safety reasons.

Report from Katie Hobley

Leisure centre in Atherstone signed off with planning.

No response from RSPCA following animal cruelty reports.

Council have stopped funding WeCare.uk

Reported that another Councillor had queried with Council Leader George Finch as to why our County Councillor for Hartshill, Jennifer Warren has not been attending any parish meeting's – Mr Finch's response was that he felt Parish Councils were not relevant and would be gone in a few years anyway.

Willow Close has passed planning, but no work has started yet.

Drone to be used to measure size of traveller site – High court injunction on site, it is a criminal offence for them to put buildings on without planning permission. Only one small black bin on site, Council to find out who is paying council tax on site.

Resident raised concerns over bollards which have been removed from small green area at Oldbury View on Castle Rd. Barriers were removed and dropped kerbs installed which now cars are parking over and residents cannot get out onto Castle Rd safely. Resident would like to request post beside dropped kerb to stop parking.

Council vans working on Drayton Court flats seen tipping paint down the drains.

Planning Application Trent View Farm

Residents raised concerns over planning application submitted for small development on land currently known as Trent View Farm. Concerns raised were loss of view (advised that this is not a valid point for objection) safety aspect as will be very overlooked, high noise levels already on Mancetter Road due to businesses already – this will be worse when building starts. Noise and dust will impact the health of vulnerable residents.

Wildlife on the site – will there be a wildlife study – rabbits, deer, foxes, badgers, bats and red kites seen on site.

Proposed junction where house to be demolished is in Nuneaton borough – yet 20 yards away is the junction with Berrington Rd, along with traffic for the Windmill, having these junctions so close will be dangerous.

Would like an archaeology and Geological review to take place if hasn't already. Councillors agreed to comment on the application and note residents' concerns in their comments.

Orchard Close – follow up to comments made at July meeting – Councillors have raised residents' concerns with relevant parties but lack the power to do anything else. Will continue to forward on comments to higher authorities.
