 - [P/FUL/2026/02776](#) – Poxwell Lower Dairy, Poxwell, DT2 8ND – Renewal of temporary planning consent P/FUL/2021/00157 for the siting of a mobile home for a dairy worker. The current consent expires on 20 August 2026 and a further ten-year consent is sought.
