

Top priorities following ISP survey results

Methodology in extracting results

Respondents were asked to rank their responses into a top 6 priority list from multiple options. We have based our results on issues that were ranked as priority 1 or 2 for each respondent and then ranked into top 5 based on these results. Percentages shown are percentage of votes for the top results.

For the online surveys we have lots of parked responses that we are unable to access unless we upgrade our membership, (42 parked responses for HIP and 35 for ISP). To retrieve these responses, we need to upgrade, this would be either £45 per month which can be cancelled at any time i.e., pay for one month then cancel or £360 for the year billed annually. There is also the option to apply for a not-for-profit discount, I do not know how much the discount is until we apply.
