A note for members' diaries: The Club's AGM will take place at Shifnal War Memorial Club on Thursday 20th February, commencing at 7:45pm. The AGM will be preceded by members' registration and payment of subscriptions, commencing at 7pm. Notice and agenda for the AGM will be forwarded to all members 2 weeks prior to the meeting.

For the 2025 Season we, the committee, have decided to increase the annual subscriptions from £35 to £40 to help towards the cost of the improvements at the green that we have done during the closed season, installing new floodlights and replacing all the inner boards around the green. - Proposed rule change to Division 1 teams consisting of 11 players.
- Proposed new rule that Junior players are to be excluded from the registered players list.
- Proposed rule change to Monday Divisions to adopt the Thursday night league scoring system. 1pt-5chalks, 2pts-10chalks, 3pts-15chalks, 4pts-20chalks & 5pts-21chalks.
- Proposed rule change to Thursday Division being limited to maximum of 12 teams.
