3793 Apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Cllr. M. Birtwistle and District Councillor Virginia von Celsing.

3794 Any declarations of pecuniary interests by members or the Clerk

The Clerk declared a pecuniary interest in 3803, KS declared an interest in 3801 and AS in 3802.

3796 To approve the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 7th March, 2016

3798 To receive a report from our District Councillor, Virginia von Celsing

3799 Clerk's report

The installation of the new swing will begin this Thursday.

3800 To consider the Flood Warden attending the Inside Government's policy forum on flooding

It was resolved that if the Flood Warden felt it was an appropriate event to attend the Parish Council would fund the fee for the forum and the expenses involved in travel.

3801 To receive a report back from those who have met with the executive committee for the Scout

DA and MB met with Rob Hill from the committee. The current outstanding balance of the loan is £1200. It was resolved to allow this to be paid back over 10 years at £120 per year.

3802 To consider providing grounds maintenance for the Church yard

A quote has been received from our contractors of £150+VAT for each cut. DA is meeting with them tomorrow and will discuss the quote further before a decision can be made.

3803 To consider which pension scheme to join for automatic enrolment and the required start date

New government legislation requires all employers to have a pension scheme. The Clerk has researched the options available and DA and MB have looked at the possible schemes available. This needs to be set up by 1 May 2017, however it was suggested that it may be appropriate to begin the scheme as soon as possible and fund from reserves.

The Clerk was requested put together the figures for the next meeting.

3804 To discuss the possible installation of a footpath on Downs Road

This item was wrongly described and should have been about a 'footway off Aldworth Road'. It was discussed that the land is not being made available and thus a footway could not be installed.

3805 To consider the Clerk attending a course on Cemetery Legal Compliance

It was resolved for the Clerk to attend this course and for expenses to be covered. A copy of the information supplied on the course should be stored centrally.

3806 To consider the provision of WIFI to parish council meetings

Groundwater level is close to the seasonal peak notwithstanding the recent showers. An emergency this year is very unlikely. The Aldworth Road bridge improvements (including the watercourse crossing for the proposed cemetery) are scheduled for May. Work is progressing through the Pang Valley Flood Forum on the possibility of using the West Berkshire Groundwater Scheme to alleviate flood risk in Compton. The next PVFF meeting is scheduled for the end of April.
