Planning

 - nor to 20/00451/APP to vary a condition relating to footway width at Site C, land south of Castle Street.
- AVDC has received appeals against the refused application 19/03519/APP for an extension and garage at Stableyard Cottage, Blackthorn Road, OX27 0AG; and 19/00091/REF re Barnwell Farm, Station Road, OX27 0HN.
- Council is investigating with AVDC when S106 payments become due when work starts at Sites B and C.
- At its next meeting Council will consider applications:
 20/00732/ACL for a lawful development certificate for a proposed single storey rear-side extension at 7 Rectory Close, OX27 OHT;
 and 20/00716/ALB to remove storage heaters and install an air-source heat pump at Rectory Cottage, Little Marsh, OX27 OAP.
