Clement was born about 1889 in Leek Staffordshire. In 1911 he was living at Inkley Row, Main Street, Gunthorpe with Father Edgar, Mother Elizabeth with two sisters and 3 brothers. He was aged 22 and his occupation is listed as Assisting in Business.

He was killed in action in France on 12th March 1915 serving with the Notts. and Derby Sherwood Foresters. He is listed on the Le Touret Memorial, Richebourg-l'Avoue, Pas De Calais Panel 26 an 27.

His brothers Eric and Jack went on to run several businesses in the Nottingham area including Metal Dealing, Office Equipment and an Antiques Shop.
