

Clerks Report for the Uffington Parish Council Meeting Monday 11th August 2025.

I am pleased to be able to report the following;

Residents Correspondence:

Following the publication of the Summer 2025 Courier and the article requesting public views on the future website, there has been one response which has been previously circulated to council members.

Burial Ground:

During the month a new memorial has been installed on Plot 25 and an interment has taken place in Plot 96.

Defibrillators:

None of the units have required use and are all available for use.

Fix My Street:

There have been numerous reports of incorrect conclusions being recorded by the operator. This has been raised with OCC Highways and a reply is outstanding.

New reports have been lodged relating to faulty lighting located on Craven Common.

General:

Following a general notice to current allotment tenants regarding the agreed increase in annual rental from 2026/7 there has been one letter received questioning this agreement. The Clerk is currently working with the Chair of the Uffington Gardens Allotment Society to arrange an Annual General Meeting to ensure that the oversight requirements of Uffington Parish Council are fulfilled.

Repairs to the village car park exit are now completed.

It appears that there was an attempt to remove the disc-net located at the south of the Jubilee Field. This has now been relocated and installation reinforced.

The organisers of 'PicnicFest' have provided all the necessary receipts in relation to the grant provided by Uffington Parish Council for the event.



All email accounts have now been migrated to the new domain uffingtonparish.gov.uk. Auto-forwarding from the previous .net email addresses has been activated to ensure no loss of correspondence. As council members confirm the new accounts are correct the old accounts will be deleted.

Construction of the new website is underway with a target for completion of October 2025.
