2	DECLARATION OF INTEREST HK: Any matters in relation to recreation and cricket field	
3	MINUTES OF LAST MEETING Minutes of 7th May 2026 were agreed and signed by CM	
4	MATTERS ARISING Dark Lane ditching spoil: It was agreed that this was not a parish council issue but the landowners have dealt with the spoil. Action closed Verge mowing complaint (COMPR2169): KP chased again earlier in the week and copied in Dale. KP to diarise for a month and then escalate further to Dale. CM asked whether we should get the verge mowed but it was agreed to leave at present. Ownership of overhanging tree at Manor House: tree has been trimmed by SH/owners. SH awaiting site plan of property to challenge highways who believe it is the landowners' responsibility. Tree pruning at back of Rowan House. This is outside Forestry remit. Action closed. Parish bins invoices: HK reported that she had spoken to RBC and agreed on invoices. They have agreed to delay progressing non-payment whilst credit notes are issued and payment made. Data Protection Officer: KP has been unable to obtain further information on exactly what our responsibilities are without attending a course. CM to investigate further. Overflow of water ditch in Bush Hill Lane. SH was not aware of photos [sent following meeting] and will now send on to Highways. Induction pack for new councillors: will be completed for March meeting for review. Agreed to remove from current action list. Updates to asset register. Complete, action closed. 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	Walk Sawbridge bridge paths to confirm if opened. Not yet completed. Write to local MP re. agreed neighbourhood governance proposal. Action completed. It was noted that a decision had been issued today confirming that two unitary councils will be created, one serving North Warwickshire and the other South Warwickshire. It is anticipated that we will become part of North Warwickshire. It was agreed that we should have devolution as an agenda item going forward. Submit ACV (Asset of Community Value) nomination for Old Olive Bush. This was submitted on 11/7. KP had chased this week and told it is with estates team and will get back to us with update. Obtain quote for replacing bench outside church. JL has quotes for plastic seats of £500 - £750. He is currently awaiting on a wooden quote. Plan is to replace two benches. 5	OPEN FORUM TO MEMBERS OF PUBLIC A parishioner pointed out that the drain at the bottom of Bush Hill Lane runs fine, it is the drain head that is incorrect. This is different to the flooding issue. It was noted that this would be covered under SH action above of sending the photos of the icy conditions which result to highways. A parishioner asked whether a village survey had taken place regarding the ACV nomination for the Old Olive Bush. The Parish Council responded to say it was discussed by WPC and agreed to submit the nomination after a number of parishioners had raised it with individual councillors. A parishioner asked what the position was regarding the number of cameras people have surrounding property which are also recording public roads etc. KP agreed to ask WALC (Warwickshire and West Midlands Association of Local Councils) as it is believed this isn't a PC responsibility. A parishioner queried what the problem was with the verge mowing. It was confirmed this is the land on the opposite side of the church going up the hill. It requires specialist equipment and seems to have come off highways land for maintenance. The owner of the Old Olive Bush reported that it was re-opening on 1st August with new tenants who are on a six year lease. The new tenants are keen to keep the skittles table and teams and plan to have a band playing on 30th August.	KP

Sawbridge speeding: • Children playing signs do not exist • Slow road marking may be possible but this is only advisory and would be subject to a highways assessment. • A community speed watch has been suggested. This would require members of the community to conduct the survey and record speeds. Training and a device can be supplied by the Neighbourhood Team and parishioners are encouraged to contact SH if they would like to pursue this. • Residents should report any antisocial or inappropriate riding to Warwickshire police
