**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & PEDESTRIANS)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2021

To allow level crossing maintenance works and other associated works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic and pedestrians on part of B2162 Hampstead Lane, Nettlestead.

A closure is planned from 12th June 2021 at 23:30, with estimated completion by 14th June 2021 at 04:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870PWS1-38-14-120621 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

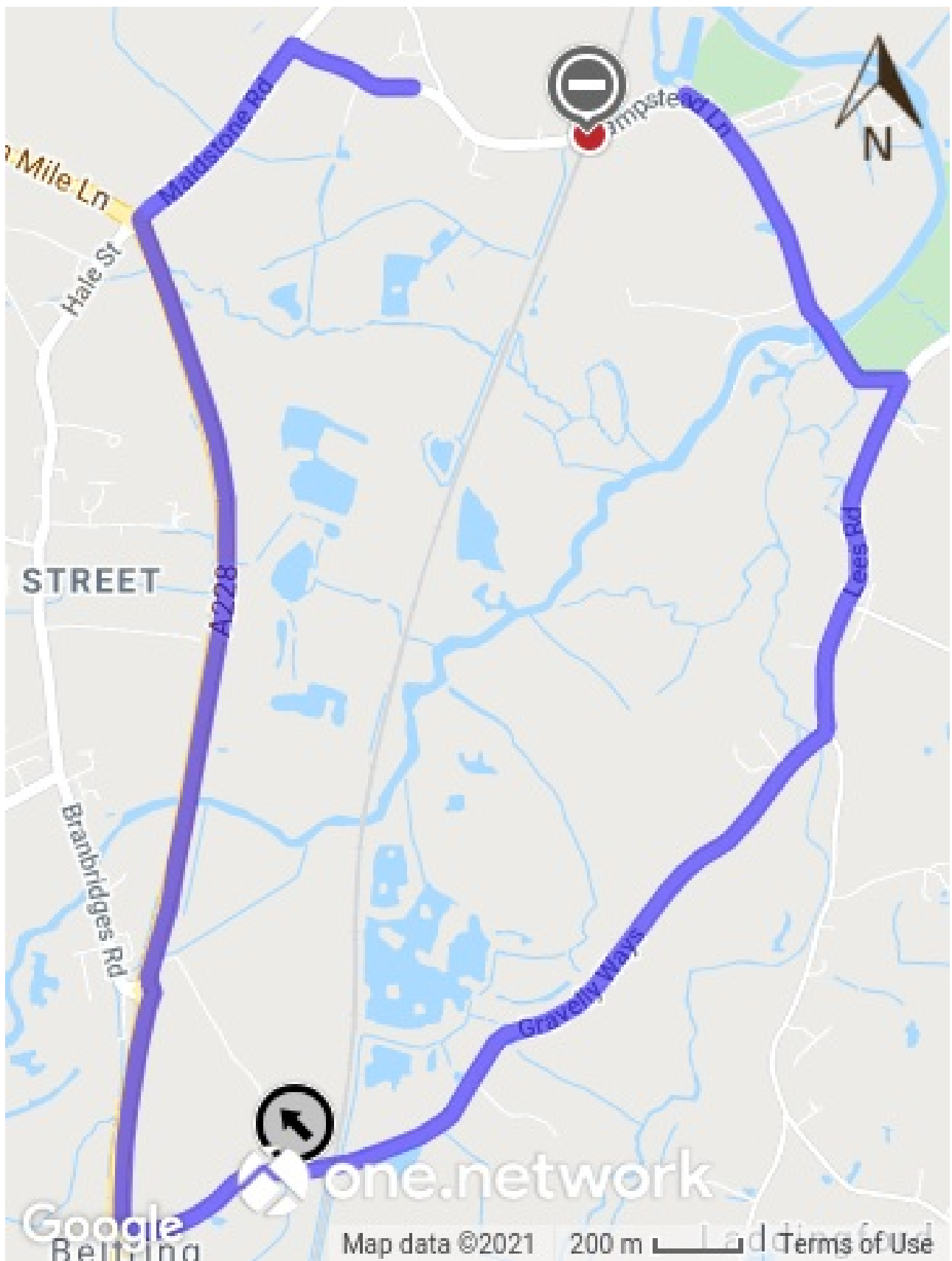
Hampstead Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while level crossing maintenance works and other associated works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Hampstead Lane, Maidstone Road, A228 Hale Street By Pass, Branbridges Road, Beltring Road, Gravelly Ways, Lees Road and vice versa.

A taxi service will be provided on site for pedestrians to use when necessary.
