Memorial Request for Section D, Row L, number 3.

Relevant section in Cemetery Rules & Regulations No 10-14

An application has been received from our stonemason H Brett & Son on behalf of one of their clients.

The request is in 5 parts, 4 of which are within the cemetery rules & regulations or have previously been sanctioned.

The 5^{th} item requested is for an $18'' \times 18''$ desk tablet that is to be placed inside of the kerb stone.

The kerb stone was removed at the time of the interment and will be replaced with all the agreed additions after the required amount of time has passed.

In normal circumstances:

- a) an 18" x 18" desk tablet is currently only allowed in Section E (ashes) and would be secured on a 2' x 2' slab.
- b) a flat stone of 15" x 15" is allowed in the grave sections of the cemetery where ashes are added to a previous burial.

The charges for these memorials are:

- a) £60 for residents, doubled for non-residents
- b) Free

There are two issues to be addressed from this request and for Cllr's to decide if:

- a) is permission given to allow for the desk tablet inside of the kerb stone
- b) is the normal fee of £60 to be charged?

Finally, to consider if the rules and regulations need to be changed to reflect the decision taken above, for future requests of this type?
