BULLET POINTS:

- Discussions held regarding outcome of Sutton Valence Housing Needs Survey detailed by ARCK
- Highest need-open market for 30 homes, 16 of these are over 60 and wanting a Bungalow. The 10 households who are need of affordable housing will be rented. $(8 \times 1 \text{ bed}, 2 \times 2 \text{ bed})$
- 86% of respondents to the survey are owner occupiers, majority of these have lived in the Parish for over 12 years
- Sutton Valence ageing population:
 155 out of 418 are over 60 (37%)
 248 out of 418 are over 45 (59%)
- 28 households expect to move in the next 2 years, 18 in the next 3-5 years, 5 in the next 5 years. 343 do not wish to move.
- There is a very high support for additional housing for locals with a genuine need. 276 people in favour with 80 against (77% v 23%)
- Exception sites- BA to contact Landowners to safeguard affordable housing
- Community Land Trust in partnership with Housing Association- BA to contact Cheryl Parks
- Local Lettings Plan-BA to contact MBC
- ARCK to break down the survey into households
- BA writing to Wealden Homes regarding up to date information on the affordable homes at Brandys Bay Development on South Lane.
- BA to search Land Registry for suitable land and contact Landowners.
