(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2024

SGN WORKS

To allow gas replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Station Road, Nettlestead.

A closure is planned from 8th January 2024, with estimated completion by 2nd February 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW039W119627856-01452-05 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Station Road will be closed at the junction with B2162 Hampstead Lane for 50 metres, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas main replacement works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Station Road, B2162 Hampstead Lane, B2015 Maidstone Road, Station Road and vice versa.
