Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held at 7.30pm on Tuesday, 19th January 2010 in the Village Hall

a) Flood Resilience Package

The Chairman confirmed the container had been delivered to Church Lane Farm. Cllr Small felt it may be better sited nearer to the risk area in the middle of the village and it was suggested the 8x9ft steel container be moved to the village hall car park. This year Ward Councillors have been given £1,000 each to fund various projects; therefore with two District Councillors here, £2,000 is available and after discussion DCllr Isard confirmed a further contribution could be made to the village hall committee for an overhaul of the electrical system. On behalf of the village hall committee Cllr P Ogle said they gratefully accepted whatever amount was offered. DCllr Isard to liaise direct with Cllr M Ogle regarding this.
