Thank you for meeting with Chideock PC on 30th May 2023 here in the Village Hall. All Councillors enjoyed meeting you and found the discussions to be of benefit also hoping that future meetings may arise from it.

In that meeting you requested that the PC identify four priorities in order for you to take the problems of the A35 through the village to a higher Government level.

Following serious consideration the PC would like to advise you of these as follows:

- 1. Alternative route or bypass to reduce traffic through the village and leading to A35 through Chideock being detrunked
- 2. Controlled Pedestrian Crossings at Bilberry and at North Road / Duck Street
- 3. Average speed cameras plus 30mph limit by Dec 2025
- 4. Delivery of improved pavements / footpaths and provision of pavements / footpaths where none currently exist
