16/325 Apologies : P Hooper – It was **RESOLVED** to accept these apologies.

16/326 Declarations of Interests: None declared

**16/327 Comments from the public:** Two members of the public spoke in relation to their desire to develop a plot of land in Chapel Lane, seeking support for a small-scale development to allow one house to be built for a local person to return to the village.

Cllr Price commented to say no opinion could be given and that the Village Design Statement designated that area as open space. He also confirmed the Neighbourhood Development Plan was underway which will be considering, amongst other matters, open spaces in the village but until that process was completed, the Parish Council would have to follow the current approved planning policy.
