Minutes of an Air Traffic Committee Meeting held in The Council Office, Langton Green Recreation Ground on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2015 at 11.30am

Matters Arising and Correspondence: Cllr Barrington-Johnson summarised the meeting that was held earlier with Greg Clark MP which was attended by members from Rusthall and Bidborough Parish Councils. Greg Clark called the meeting to update himself with the views of Parish Councils. He said that he had canvassed residents via a leaflet sent to every household asking for a questionnaire to be filled in and returned.
  - Having listened to the attendees Greg Clark said that he was opposed to any Gatwick expansion and the narrowing of the flight path and was still in favour of the Estuary airport, which he

believed had been dismissed too early. He would incorporate mitigation should the Gatwick expansion go ahead.

- **8. Airports Commission Autumn consultation:** Cllr Barrington-Johnson had produced a detailed response to the consultation and he was congratulated by committee members on his work. There were some minor alterations which he would incorporate and circulate a new version prior to sending the final document.
- **9.** Consideration of the content of the Air Traffic web page: It was agreed to leave any amendments to the website until after the consultation was finished.
