As part of the works, we will be erecting an external scaffold to provide access to both the roof and the external walls which will be situated around the perimeter of The Almonry. To ensure optimum safety of the public and local community we will be erecting a timber hoarding to enclose the scaffold, which will result in a footpath closure to the section of the High Street directly outside The Almonry.

The hoarding and adjacent to it will be sufficiently lit with adequate signage in place for the duration of the works.

We politely request that all stakeholders are mindful of road traffic safety when needing to cross the road. If you require any assistance with this at any time during the works, we will happily assist where we can and we apologise for any inconvenience caused.
