A MEETING WAS HELD AT ATCHAM PARISH MEETING ROOMS IN APRIL, TO DISCUSS THE ON-GOING CONCERNS WITH THE LACK OF GROUNDS MAINTENANCE AND DEBT COLLECTION LETTERS MANY RESIDENTS HAD RECEIVED.

A VOTE TOOK PLACE AND A NEW RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION WAS FORMED TO TRY AND TACKLE THE CONCERNS OF THE RESIDENTS.

ADRIAN TACCHI WAS NOMINATED AS CHAIRPERSON OF THE ASSOCIATION AND MARYANN ATTER AGREED TO ACT AS VICE-CHAIR, WITH THE SUPPORT OF SOPHIE HANSON AS SECRETARY AND TREASURER.

TEN RESIDENTS FROM ACROSS THE DEVELOPMENT HAVE ALSO VOLUNTEERED TO BECOME COMMITTEE MEMBERS.

What is a Resident's Association? Why should I become a member?

A Residents Association is bound by a constitution to act on behalf of its Residents.

The aims of this Association are:

- To be inclusive of all residents, including the views of children and young people.
- To represent and promote the interests and rights of residents.
- To work towards improving the quality of life for local people and their community.

Views of children and young people will always be considered by the Association.



With thanks to Atcham Parish Council, there will be no membership fee, due to a grant secured to fund the association for the first 12 months.

As a member of the Association, you will be kept up to date on all key meetings organised; including any items raised by residents.

You will receive a copy of the constitution, contact details for committee members, details of any planned meetings and how to submit an agenda item.
