Falling and injury	Children	<p>Take advice from equipment manufacturer</p> <p>Have regular inspections of equipment to ensure it continues to operate to standard and no hazards have developed.</p> <p>Rectify any hazards identified in the report at earliest opportunity.</p> <p>Put up sign that the play equipment is used at own risk.</p> <p>Install safety matting on the ground around the equipment to cushion any falls.</p>	<p>Clerk to liaise with Infinity</p> <p>Quarterly inspection by Infinity Minor repairs to be undertaken as part of inspection.</p> <p>Clerk to liaise with Infinity or Greensmile at earliest opportunity. If recommended by Infinity equipment piece to be boarded off or removed until hazard is rectified.</p> <p>Sign has been installed</p> <p>Matting to be inspected regularly. Replacement of safety matting with more durable alternative to be considered</p>	<p>Ensure insurance is sufficient and kept up to date.</p> <p>Good working relationship with maintenance and inspection contractors</p> <p>HWC</p>	2	6	8
