**RBC**

The planning committee will be meeting on 20<sup>th</sup> June.

A caravan count will be taking place over the next few weeks. Figures will be used by the planning services working party and a consultation will be carried out later this year following the findings.

Cllr Gillias continues to attend the Magna Park liaison meetings and trying to effect levels of traffic in the rural villages. There will be an upgrade to the A5 between the M69 and the M1. Cllr Gillias has been successful in assisting with a new routing agreement for lorries that are part of new leases at Magna Park.

**WCC**

Congratulations to all for becoming Councillors. The outlook for the financial future of Warwickshire County Council is looking difficult due to the impact of Covid-19. Warwickshire County Council have set up a recovery infrastructure fund of £160million over the next 4 years. The aim is to save 4000 jobs and create 2200 jobs.

Warwickshire County council are setting up a property company to develop parcels of their own land as an alternative to selling land/buildings to developers. The money derived from this will be used for services. A green survey is currently being carried out alongside a transport survey available on the Warwickshire County Council website.

Following a question regarding traveller encampments Cllr Warwick stated the letter from the MP will be extremely useful in the future and carries significant weight.

Cllr Warwick stated if the parish were to set up a community speed watch initiative, he could assist by lending the speed gun. It was raised that the 30mph signs upon entering the villages are obscured by overhanging trees, Cllr Smith to attend.
