Parish Council Report

This is the time of year when we are required to hold the Annual Parish Council Meeting to formally confirm appointments of Chair and Vice-Chair. This meeting will be held at 19:30 on 26th May and will be held in person at the pavilion. We would usually also have annual reports from the various committees and clubs that operate in Moulsford but, as we still have Covid restrictions on numbers in the pavilion, we will publish the reports in the Moulsford News.

There are other small signs that things may be returning to something resembling "normal". The events committee are arranging the resumption of Friday evening socials outside the pavilion even though their first event was thwarted by the inclement May weather. Further outdoor events are planned from 28th May and, hopefully, we can resume the full Friday evening pavilion events later in June if the government releases its restrictions. Meanwhile, back at the recreation ground ...

The Recreation Ground Working Group, including most of the PC, met up last month for a wet and windy walkabout of the Rec to look at how all the ideas that had been discussed at meetings might work on the ground. We are now in the process of getting an updated map which shows all these ideas ready for consultation with the community. The emphasis has been very much on making the most of what we already have (including the beautiful location) and ensuring that the open, green, treed character of the Rec is preserved, while making some careful additions here and there. We are also preparing to get some essential tree maintenance underway and when Covid restrictions have eased and if the weather gives us a break, we will be holding some woodland and playground work parties to which villagers will be most welcome. From the Vicar Andrew Petit

My Dear Friends,

By the time you see this we will have just celebrated what is often known as *Whitsun* or *Whit Sunday*. You may be surprised to know that traditionally it is regarded as the second greatest festival in the Christian calendar after Easter – in other words even more important than Christmas!

So what is *Whitsun*? It was called *Whitsun* (i.e. "White Sunday") because for many centuries it was one of the main days, like Easter, when new followers of Christ were baptised, traditionally wearing white clothes as a sign of their new life. It always takes place 7 weeks after Easter, which means that like Easter it doesn't have a fixed date but ranges from early May to early June and celebrates the day when the Holy Spirit was first poured out on Jesus' disciples at the great Jewish festival of Pentecost.

After Jesus had risen from the dead, over a period of nearly 6 weeks he frequently appeared to the disciples and instructed them that they would be witnesses to who he was, to his teaching and to his resurrection, throughout the whole world. The disciples felt totally inadequate to such a great task, but Jesus told them not to try and do anything until the Holy Spirit had come upon them. 10 days after Jesus had ascended into heaven the disciples were praying together in an upper room in Jerusalem when they had the most extraordinary experience of the Holy Spirit coming upon them. There was a sound like a mighty rushing wind, they saw what looked like tongues of flame resting on each of their heads, they were filled with a wonderful joy and found they could not stop proclaiming the wonders of God.

Having previously been anxiously hiding away for fear of being arrested by the religious authorities or the Romans, Jesus' disciples now found themselves being catapulted out of that upper room into the streets, and fearlessly proclaiming who Jesus was and what he had done to the vast crowds that had gathered in Jerusalem for the Jewish festival. St Luke tells us that about 3,000 people became followers of Jesus on that day and that was just the beginning. This is why Pentecost or *Whitsun* is sometimes referred to as "the birthday of the church". From Jerusalem, those very ordinary disciples spread the good news about Jesus across the whole of the known world. It was the beginning of the most remarkable and influential movement in the whole of human history.

Many of us have been locked in not only by the official restrictions, but by our own, albeit well-founded, fears of the effects of *Coronavirus*. Even as restrictions ease, some may feel apprehensive about going out into the big wide world and resuming what used to be our normal human face-to-face contact. There will no doubt be set-backs from time to time, but we can take great encouragement from those early disciples of Jesus: they knew that they could do nothing in their own strength, but as they prayed and opened themselves up to God, they were given a divine energy and power, which enabled them to do far more than they or anyone else could possibly imagine! 


