NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING

The NHP steering group now have their inception meeting and site visits planned with Feria Urbanism, the group's chosen consultants. Following the gathering of information at this first stage, the consultants will aid the group in preparing for a Visioning Event and Three-Day Forum, which will give the community a first chance to get involved in the process of Neighbourhood Planning. The Clerk will continue to provide updates under the parish council's website in the section headed 'Neighbourhood Plan' and on the noticeboards, so look out for further information.

## TRAFFIC SOLUTIONS PROJECT

You may have noticed some new posts going in around the village. These are for the implementation of the Speed Indicator Devices (SID's) which will monitor traffic speeds and remind traffic moving through the village to keep within the speed limit. The SIDs will also record traffic speed data which can be used at a future date if required as evidence of the volume of traffic speeding through the village.

The designs for the new village gateways and changes to the white lining on the Lamberhurst side of the cross roads are still with the Traffic consultants and KCC design team at present and we hope to move forward with these as soon as we can.

The Parish Council are most grateful to KCC for their recent grant funding of £2000 towards these projects.
