## 5. <u>Matters Arising from 7<sup>th</sup> October 2014</u>

## a) Footpaths and stiles:

Pat has received notification that the stile at Egerton House has been fixed, Pat has been to check and it is not fixed sufficiently, the Clerk is to ask R James & Sons fencing to fix. Pat has so far not followed up the progress of the way marker at Wildings.

The Clerk is to follow up the offer of the land owner at Hazeldene for a new gate to the bridle way.

The footpath sign directing walkers to Coldharbour Farm on the corner of Forstal Road and Bedlam Lane at Brookgate was knocked over when a vehicle left the road and went through the hedge. This has been reported to KCC.

A letter from KCC highways has been received showing proposed diversion of part of Public footpath AW99. Following discussions the council proposed to support the diversion, the Clerk will write with the Councils decision. Action: Clerk

## b) Highways:

Peter Rawlinson and Richard Wall are still working on the mapping of drains within the village. Stonebridge Green Road is closed from 3 November for five days to connect a new electricity supply and also to repair the drain under the road to properties at Willow Farm. Bill reports that Southern water have informed him that a non-return valve is to be fitted at the end of Forge Lane with secure man-hole covers with the hope it will help with flooding problems. Bill is awaiting a date for works to commence.

- c) Welcome packs. Pat has delivered a Welcome pack to the new owners of Squirrel Lodge in Forstal Road.
- d) Village confines: Peter will report next month, as he is awaiting a response from Challock PC.
  Peter is also to contact ABC to ask Stephanie Viney in planning if there is a map available to show previous areas of confines. There is also the Egerton Parish Design Statement for Peter to consider.
