

The Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on the 5th May 2026, at the Styrrup Village Hall, commencing at 19.00hrs

23.05.05.2026 Items from the public if any
There were 9 members of the public present.

The concerns raised were

- 1) Playground in need of repair – this was known by the members and is in the process of repair by an outside company.
- 2) The stile from the Field to the play area has a bottom rail missing and this means small dogs can enter the play area. Cllr Starkie will attend to this ASAP.
- 3) It was agreed that No Smoking signs were not enough in the Hall as some public members were then vaping. New signs will be supplied
- 4) It was asked if Wi-Fi for the Hall was still to come. The answer was yes and this will be installed soon.
- 5) All of the attendees asked why the Village Hall was installing a flagpole flying the Union flag. It was explained that the intention was for a small memorial garden and the flagpole could be part of an armistice ceremony, as Styrrup currently did not have such an area. It was thought by the residents that in this current climate, no flagpole was required and indeed they had lost the meaning they should have. Concern was raised as to why the residents had not been consulted. It was explained that this had to be submitted to Bassetlaw council and they would get an opportunity to oppose it then formally. The members were still of the opinion that it would go ahead.
- 6) There seems to be someone who is urinating in the bus stop, causing a smell for other users. It happens regularly, early in the morning, before the 8.00am bus. This will be passed on to the PCSO for the area.
- 7) The caravans are due for Bank Holiday weekend, and they asked if the price per night could be held for 2027. The site has no facilities; they pay extra for the Hall. It was agreed that this could be done.
- 8) The caretaker would like to organise an inside market for later this year. It needs a new licence from Bassetlaw, and it was agreed that she would apply for this.
- 9) It was also asked if there could be a Summer Fayre, along with Scarecrow event later and this was also agreed with the proper licences.
- 10) Finally, a concern was raised about Speeding on Main Street. This has been an ongoing battle for many years now. There is a frequent speed watch by volunteers on Main Street and the PC installed a new speed sign near to Pagdin Drive this year. Another sign will be investigated.
