GREEN STEWARDS' DUTIES

Green Stewards to attend half an hour before the start of the session to hand out match cards and collect green fees, leaving them free to play in that session.

Stewards to pay green fees into the Club safe.

Lock up at the end of the session.

Arrange for a deputy to carry out these duties when unable to attend.

Inform the Senior Green Steward when any difficulty arises or in case of emergency.

Be responsible for the smooth running of the session.

NOTE – it will greatly assist the Green Stewards if team captains ensure that their green fees are paid in at least five minutes before the start of the session. In the event that a team captain is late, a team member should undertake to pay in the fees by the time stated above.

Please acquaint yourself with the Club Constitution and Rules and be mindful that it is in your own interests to refer regularly to the Noticeboards. If you wish to join a league team please enter your name and telephone number, and state the league(s) you are interested in joining, on the lists which are displayed on the Noticeboard alongside Rink No. 1.

Team Captains are asked to kindly consider these new Members when seeking to make up any shortages in their team numbers.

WEDNESDAY MORNINGS (10.00 am to 12.00 noon) WEDNESDAY AFTERNOONS (2.00 pm to 4.30 pm)

These sessions are available for roll-ups. New members of the Club are always welcome to come and join in.

Two rinks for morning sessions and four rinks for afternoon are usually available. A list, on which you may sign your name in advance, is displayed on the Noticeboard.

NOTE - It will greatly assist the Green Stewards if you could arrive and pay your fees at least 10 minutes before the start of the session. This will allow time for the Green Stewards to allocate your rink and to pay in the Fees collected.

At all times, priority over rinks is given to Ladies' National Competitions. Please consult the handbook for Wednesdays when mid-week friendly matches are arranged.

NATIONAL COMPETITIONS 2013/2014

This season the following evening rinks are available for 4 hour sessions: 2 rinks on Mondays, 3 rinks on Tuesdays, 3 rinks on Wednesdays and 3 rinks on Thursdays. These are the only weekday evening rinks which may be used. Competitors wishing to book these rinks, and those wishing to book rinks at other times outside Club time, will have to book through the Recreation Centre using the Club booking form. No payment will be necessary at the time of booking, bills will be raised by the Club Treasurer.

Ladies' Nationals may be played on Wednesday Afternoons on the rinks not booked by the Club using the above booking procedures. In the event of these not heing available, one of the Club rinks may be booked through the Secretary, David Newman (01252) 691258.

CHANGING/LOCKER ROOMS

COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Any player competing shall be a current member of the Bowling Club.
- 2. All competitions shall be played in accordance with the RULES FOR TWO HOUR MATCHES, except that all competitions up to the semi-finals shall be limited to a 2 hour time limit, irrespective of the number of ends completed. Within this time limit the maximum number of ends is 18, except for the Senior Two Wood Triples which shall be a maximum of 21 ends.
- 3. Players taking part in the first game shall constitute the team, after which, with the exception of mixed competitions, one substitute only may be used by any one team. In mixed competitions one lady only and one man only may be used to replace a lady and a man respectively. Any such substitution shall be advised to the Competition Secretaries within 24 hours of the game being played. In exceptional cases, but only with the prior approval of the Competition Secretary, a second substitute may be allowed in the Ladies' and Men's rinks. If the competitor named in the programme is substituted, the replacement shall notify the Competition Secretary to obtain approval.
- 4. The Mixed Fours competition shall comprise two ladies and two men only.
- The Men's Senior Two Wood Triples is open to men who are 60 years of age and over.
- Competitors shall put their Bowls Club number on the back of the score card.
- a) SINGLES First to 21 shots. Players may visit the head. (Ladies' singles must be played to 21 shots with no time limit.)
 - b) DRAWN GAMES In the event of a game being drawn, the competitor with the most winning ends shall be declared the winner. If this does not produce a winner, the score at the previous end to count.
 - c) SEMI FINALS and FINALS Full game to be played with no time limit.
- Finalists of Men's competitions qualify for County play-offs. Winner of Ladies' Singles qualifies for National Champion of Champions competition in the following season.
- 9. Games should be played on the scheduled date, but may be played before that date with the agreement of the opponent and prior approval of the Competition Secretary. The extra costs incurred shall be the responsibility of the player requesting the change.
- CONCEDED GAMES The respective Competition Secretary must be notified immediately concession is known. The cost of an unused rink is the responsibility of the defaulter(s).
- 11. Competitions must be commenced within 10 minutes of the published starting time. Should, at this time, any team be without the full complement of players, they shall forfeit the game. Defaulters to meet the cost of the rink.

LEAGUE RULES

- Any person playing in the league shall be a member of the Club.
- All league matches, with the exception of the Men's National League, shall be played in accordance with the RULES FOR TWO HOUR MATCHES, except where otherwise stated. The Men's National League shall be played to the normal rules of bowls, with a maximum of 21 ends within a 3 hour time limit, but Rule 6 below shall apply.
- In all leagues each team shall have at least six playing members. Additional players may be introduced to the team during the course of the season, but shall not have played, or been registered, for any other team in either division of that league.
- An open league team shall be either single gender or mixed.
- 5. A league match may not be postponed by either team. Should a team fail to attend by 15 minutes after the scheduled start time of a match, the game will be conceded to the non-offending team and 2 league points plus 10 shots awarded. The defaulting team shall be responsible for the whole cost of the rink, including their opponents' share plus a £1 administration fee.
- In a RINKS game only, when a team is one player short, the game shall proceed but:
 - 6.1 In the defaulting team, the number of bowls shall be made up by the Lead and Second player, playing 3 bowls each, and
 - 6.2 One fourth of the total shots scored, by each team comprising 3 players, shall be deducted automatically from their final score, when the match results are entered into the league tables. (fractions shall be taken into account).
 - 6.3 Where both teams are 1 player short, Rule 6.1 & 6.2 shall apply.
 - 6.4 The start time of game may be delayed by up to 15 minutes, during which time a late player may join his/her team. After this time a late player may not join the team and the game shall proceed as in 6.1 & 6.2 above.
 - 6.5 Should a team repeatedly play with 1 player short, a warning shall be given by the League Secretary to the offending team captain. Further occurrences will be dealt with by applying penalties as in Rule 5 above.
- 7. If play is stopped due to an emergency outside the control of the Club, the result shall stand if 5 or more ends have been played. If less than 5 ends have been played the match shall be deemed cancelled and no league points or shots will be awarded to either team. However, if the stoppage is only temporary and the game is resumed and completed then the final score shall stand.
- Owing to the high cost of indoor jacks, the skips shall be jointly responsible for returning the jack to the Green Steward, and may be asked to reimburse the Club in the event that it is lost due to their neglect of this requirement.
- At the end of a match, both skips shall be responsible for checking that the two score cards tally and, after signing them to that effect, for putting them in the rack provided for the purpose.

LEAGUE POINTS

1. Two points will be awarded for a win and one point each for a tie.

RULES FOR TWO-HOUR MATCHES

- 1. Matches shall be of 18 ends or two hours' duration, whichever is the earlier.
- 2. The jack shall be delivered in the normal manner, but if delivered out of the rink shall be placed by the opposing skip. The lead may also reposition the mat but this must be completed before the jack is set by the skip. In singles matches the jack will be delivered in the normal manner by the opposing player.
- If, during play, the jack is put out of the confines of the rink, the end shall be replayed, except if this occurs after the five minute bell has rung.
- 4. Players are not allowed to:
 - a) remain at the head while their opposite number bowls
 - b) follow a wood down the rink
 - c) visit the head
- 5. Skips shall leave the head as soon as it is their turn to bowl, and shall not hold long discussions with any member of their team before they bowl. Other members of the team shall not go to the head until all the players, other than the skips, have delivered their bowls. If a skip has to temporarily leave the green, they will not be replaced at the head.
- 6. Bells will be rung at the time of start and at five minutes before the end of a session. The jack must be in place when the bell is rung to signal the final five minutes. If it is, then the last end will be played to a finish.
- 7. If a wood, on its original course down the Green, is deemed to be on a collision course with a static wood on a neighbouring rink, the latter shall be lifted to allow the moving wood to pass and shall then be replaced as near as possible to its original position. If more than one static wood is involved, and it is deemed not to be possible to carry out the above procedure with all these woods, the moving wood shall be stopped and replayed. However, in the event that the game on the neighbouring rink is to the full rules of bowls, in particular National or County competitions, the procedure laid down by those rules shall be applied.

LEAGUE NOTES

Each team has its own scorecard for recording the result of each end played.

Initials and surname of players in your team must be entered on the LEFT-HAND side of the scorecard, and the names of the opposing team on the RIGHT-HAND side.

It is advisable to compare scorecards regularly during the game, so that any discrepancies can be corrected at an early stage.

When signing the scorecard at the end of the game, please check that all details are correct - this will assist greatly the League Secretary in determining the result thus ensuring accuracy in the compilation of the League Tables.

Signed scorecards must be placed in the rack provided behind the Green Stewards' Table, at the end of each game.

Any queries regarding the accuracy of the published League Tables should be directed, in writing, to the League Secretary.

GENERAL RULES OF CLUB

CONDUCT

All Members will observe, at all times, rules of conduct and play that are displayed.

NOTICES

All notices placed on the noticeboard during the season shall be deemed sufficient intimation to all members.

DRESS CODE

All Members shall wear smooth-soled, heel-less footwear.

RIBC Leagues, Club Competitions and Roll-Ups: RIBC shirts or predominantly white above the waist; grey below.

Interclub Friendly Games:-

- (a) Men RIBC shirts or white shirts with tie above the waist; grey or white below (depending on fixture).
- (b) Ladies RIBC shirts, white or club colours above the waist; grey or white below (depending on fixture).

County Leagues: RIBC shirts above the waist; white below.

County/National Competitions: RIBC or white above the waist, ladies may wear club colours; grey or white below (depending on fixture).

Teams must all wear the same.

COMPLAINTS

Complaints shall be sent in writing to the Secretary for the Committee's consideration.

HOURS OF PLAY

Details of session times and matches will be shown in the Club handbook.

FIRING

In the interests of safety, a player intending to fire during the course of a game or a roll-up shall clearly warn the players on the rink and the two adjoining rinks. Failure to do this will render the offender liable for any damage to a third party or to property, and may result in disciplinary action by the Executive Committee.

TIMING BELL AND WALL CLOCK

The bell which regulates the start and finish of all our games operates automatically from a digital timer which is housed in one of the cupboards.

The wall clock is a standalone clock and is reasonably accurate, but it operates quite independently of our bell and it should <u>not</u> be used to question the accuracy of our bell.

SEVERE WEATHER PROCEDURE

The following procedure is to be implemented in the event of severe snow, ice or flooding etc, which causes the Leisure Centre to close and/or prevents team members, teams, or Green Stewards reaching the Leisure Centre.

1.0. LEISURE CENTRE CLOSED

If the centre closes then clearly rinks will not be available for play. In this event the procedure will be as follows:-

1.1 Leisure Centre Management will inform RIBC immediately a decision is made to close the centre, and to give some indication of length of closure if at all possible.

Contact for Centre will be - Bookings Coordinator

Contact for RIBC will be - League Secretary and/or Treasurer

- 1.2 The League Secretary or Treasurer will inform the Senior Green Steward (and other club officials as necessary) of the closure details.
- 1.3 The Senior Green Steward will inform the Green Stewards of those leagues affected by the closure as soon as possible.
- 1.4 The Green Stewards will inform the Team Captains of the affected leagues.
- 1.5 The Team Captains will inform their Team Members as appropriate.

2.0. SESSIONS CANCELLED BY CLUB OFFICIALS

If, in the opinion of Club Officials (at least two of the Secretary, Treasurer, League Secretary, Competitions Secretary, or Senior Green Steward), conditions are considered too bad or dangerous for play, they may cancel whole sessions or day's play.

Due regard is to be given to the Local radio forecasts which advise on travel and other conditions. In this event, the procedure will be as in sections 1.2 to 1.5 above.

NOTE – In both the above cases (sections 1.0 & 2.0), neither team will be liable for the cost of green fees.

3.0. OTHERS

If you have **not** been contacted (as in 1.0 or 2.0 above) you may assume that rinks are available for play. If you are <u>unable</u> to reach the centre to play your match, you are required to inform the club as detailed below:

- 3.1 Team Members Contact your Team Captain and advise him/her that you <u>cannot</u> reach the centre and therefore <u>cannot</u> play. (This will enable the Team Captain to determine whether he/she is able to field a team)
- 3.2 Team Captains Based on the inputs received from your various Team Members, contact your opposing Team Captain and determine whether or not you can hoth field a team. If you cannot, then either you or your opposing Captain should inform the Green Steward that you have cancelled the match. If you can both field a team, one of you should inform the Green Steward accordingly.

NOTE As per League Rules, rule 5 states that matches may not be postponed or cancelled by either team. Therefore, in the event of a cancellation by one team only, they are responsible for the full cost of the green fees. If it is a joint decision, each team will be responsible for their share of the cost.

Not bothering to turn-up for a match without informing the Club and/or your opposing captain leaves you liable for the full cost of both teams green fees.

3.3 Green Stewards – If you are unable to reach the Centre and are aware that some matches will be played (as detailed in 3.2 above) you should contact the Senior Green Steward and advise him of the situation. He will attempt to find a replacement for you.

In the event of cancellations have occurred please make a note on the score cards of any relevant information so that the Treasurer and League Secretary are fully aware of the cancellation details.

HAMPSHIRE PATRONS' ASSOCIATION

The patrons play matches against clubs within the County and also against Patrons' Associations from neighbouring counties. These matches are very competitive and of a high standard. The Patrons' teams are drawn from club members who have paid a subscription to join the Patrons' Association. Clubs are allocated a number of matches for each of which they are asked to provide a rink.

Membership of the Patrons is available to all Club members for an annual subscription of £2.50. Alternatively, Club members may opt to become Life Patrons by paying a once-off subscription of £25, when they will be issued with a certificate and a special lapel badge. There is no age limit to this form of membership. Life members under the old, now defunct, scheme remain eligible to play in Patrons' matches.

Club members are urged to support the County by joining the Patrons' Association.

By doing this they will be helping the County finances as well as having the opportunity of playing in some very enjoyable matches. The subscription is collected by the Treasurer with the Club Membership fees when he bills you for next season.

A list of matches will be posted on the notice board at the start of the season, and members of the Patrons will be invited to indicate which of these they are available to play in. The rink representing this club will, where possible, be selected from those names and will in turn be posted on the notice board.

LADIES' COUNTY PATRONS' ASSOCIATION

The HCWIBA set up a Patrons' Association in 1994/95. Its aim is to raise funds for the Association. Membership costs £1 per annum.

RUSHMOOR INDOOR BOWLING CLUB CONSTITUTION AND RULES

1. NAME AND PREMISES

The Club shall be called RUSHMOOR INDOOR BOWLING CLUB.

2. ADDRESS

FARNBOROUGH RECREATION CENTRE, FARNBOROUGH, HANTS GUI 47LA.

3. OBJECTS

The objects of the Club shall be, in conjunction with the Recreation Centre, to promote and further the game of Bowls and Social Activities between members and members of other clubs with similar interests; and to play the game in accordance with the Laws of the Game governing Indoor Bowls as formulated by the World Indoor Bowls Council.

4. AFFILIATION

The Club shall be registered in due form with the English Indoor Bowling Association, the English Women's Indoor Bowling Association, the Hampshire Indoor Bowls Association and the Hampshire Women's Indoor Bowling Association, and shall conduct its affairs in accordance with the Constitution and Rules of these bodies.

5. MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all, independently of their membership of any other club. Members shall abide by the Constitution and the various rules of the Club, as laid down in the Club Handbook. They shall also abide by the Laws of the Game and any relevant rules of the National and County Associations. They shall be required to affirm this in writing on joining, and also at each annual renewal of membership.

6. OFFICERS

- 6.1. The Officers of the Club shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Chairman, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, League Secretary, Match Secretary, Men's Competition Secretary, Ladies' Competition Secretary, Captain, Vice-Captain, Men's County Representative, Ladies' County Representative and Senior Green Steward.
- 6.2. The President shall in alternate years be a man then a lady, and so on. When the President is a lady the Vice-President shall be a man, and vice versa. The man shall perform the duties of Men's President and the lady the duties of Ladies' President.
- 6.3. The Secretary may be a man or a lady, and the Assistant Secretary shall be of the opposite gender. The man shall be the Men's Secretary for the purpose of communication with the men's national and county associations, and similarly for the lady and the ladies' national and county associations.
- 6.4. The Captain may be a lady or a man, and the Vice-Captain shall normally be of the opposite gender.

7. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- 7.1. The Executive Committee shall consist of the Club Officers, together with 2 men and 2 ladies duly elected at the AGM, and 2 representatives of Centre Management.
- 7.2. The Committee shall meet at least 4 times from September to April. Six members plus the Chairman or Acting Chairman (who shall have the casting vote) shall constitute a quorum.
- 7.3. The Executive Committee shall have the power to co-opt additional members.

8. SUB-COMMITTEES

- 8.1. The Executive Committee shall delegate some of the day-to-day running of the Club to Sub-Committees constituted as follows:
 - (a) Competition Sub-Committee The 2 Competition Secretaries plus 3 others.
 - (b) Selection Sub-Committees
 - Friendlies By arrangement between the Captain and Vice-Captain.
 - Men's Competitive Teams Captain/Vice-Captain plus 4 mcn. Ladies' Competitive Teams - Captain/Vice-Captain plus 4 ladies.
 - (c) League Sub-Committee League Secretary plus 4 others.
 - (d) Finance Sub-Committee
 Chairman, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Secretary and Assistant Secretary.
 - (e) Emergency Sub-CommitteePresident, Vice-President, Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.
- 8.2. The quorum for all Sub-Committees shall be 3 members present,
- 8.3. The Sub-Committees shall be appointed by the Executive Committee.

9. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- 9.1. The Annual General Meeting shall be held before the termination of the season. It shall receive the reports of the Executive Committee and the provisional accounts for the current season. It shall consider propositions and proposals for alteration to the Rules, and shall elect Officers and other members of the Executive Committee with the exception of the representatives of Centre Management. The new Committee will not take office until after the end of the playing season.
- 9.2. Not less than 28 days before the meeting, the Secretary shall notify members of the date by means of a notice on the Club Noticeboard in the Bowls Hall. The notice shall also invite members to:
 - (a) Nominate candidates for office on a sheet provided for that purpose.
 - (b) Make any propositions, including amendments to this Constitution and the various Club Rules, by not later than 14 days before the date of the meeting.
- 9.3. All nominations shall be duly seconded, and also signed by the candidates to signify their willingness to stand. Only nominations made by this procedure will normally be accepted. The only exception to be allowed will be in the case that there is no nomination by the date of the meeting, in which case nominations will be accepted from the floor.

- 9.4. Not less than 7 days before the meeting, the Secretary shall post on the Club Noticeboard the full agenda, including details of all propositions, duly seconded.
- 9.5. A quorum shall consist of 30 members present at the meeting, not including members of the Executive Committee. If the quorum is not reached, a second date shall be arranged for the meeting. If at the second meeting the quorum is still not reached, the members of the Executive Committee present shall have the power to decide whether or not to proceed with the meeting.
- 9.6. All voting on propositions and amendments to the Rules shall be by show of hands. So also will voting for election of Officers and Committee, unless otherwise requested by any one member present.

10. SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

A Special General Meeting shall be called by the Executive Committee within 21 days of a written request signed by not less than 15 members, stating the nature of the business they wish to discuss. Notice of the agenda shall be posted on the Club Noticeboard at least 7 days prior to the date of the meeting. Quorum requirements shall be the same as for an Annual General Meeting.

11. AUTUMN GENERAL MEETING

A meeting of members shall be held in the week prior to the first week of each season. The purpose of the meeting shall be to help new members to find league places, to receive reports as determined by the Executive Committee, to deal with matters outstanding from the Annual General Meeting, to present trophies to the League and Competition winners and runners-up from the previous season and to receive the audited accounts from the previous season.

12. FINANCE

- 12.1. All matters affecting the income and expenditure of the Club shall be controlled by the Executive Committee.
- 12.2. The financial year of the Club shall end on the last day of June, and provisional accounts up to this date shall be presented to the Annual General Meeting. Final audited accounts shall be presented for approval at the Autumn General Meeting.

13. REWARD FOR SERVICES

Any person may be nominated by the Executive Committee, on an annual basis, for reward for services to the Club. Such nomination(s) shall be submitted to the Annual General Meeting for approval.

14. DISSOLUTION

If at any General Meeting of the Club, a resolution be passed calling for the dissolution of the Club, the Secretary shall immediately convene a Special General Meeting of the Club to be held not less than one month thereafter to discuss and vote on the resolution.

If at that Special General Meeting, the resolution is carried by at least two thirds of the Members present at the Meeting, the Executive Committee shall thereupon, or at a date as shall have been specified in the resolution, proceed to realise the assets of the Club and discharge all debts and liabilities of the Club.

After discharging all debts and liabilities of the Club, each fully paid up member shall, if the resolution is called for during an indoor season, have their annual membership fee for that year refunded. The remainder of the assets shall be given to some other voluntary organisation(s) having objects similar to those of the Club, or to Charities of the Executive Committee's choosing.

This transfer to be agreed at a further Special General Meeting of all those Members at the time of Dissolution, who have been Members for at least three years. The normal two thirds majority will apply.

15. ALTERATIONS TO CONSTITUTION AND RULES

The Constitution and various Club Rules may only be altered or rescinded by a resolution passed by at least two-thirds of the members present and voting at either an Annual or a Special General Meeting called for that purpose. Notice of the proposition shall be duly given in accordance with the rules laid down for the Annual General Meeting.

16. DISCIPLINARY ACTION

The Executive Committee shall be empowered to take disciplinary action against any member of the Club who fails to abide by the Constitution and/or Rules of the Club. Such disciplinary action may take the form of a warning (verbal or written), temporary suspension from selected or all activities of the Club, a fine, or termination of Club membership.

17. DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

In the first instance the alleged offender shall be made aware that he/she is being investigated, stating the reason why. The alleged offence shall then be considered by the Executive Committee at an initial hearing to determine if there is a case to answer. If this is found to be the case, the alleged offender shall be advised in writing of the allegation against him/her. He/she shall also be invited to attend a formal hearing before the Executive Committee and informed of his/her right to be represented.

At the hearing the allegation shall be reiterated to the alleged offender, and he/she shall be allowed to answer the allegation and to ask relevant questions. The hearing shall also hear evidence from any witnesses called by the Committee and/or the alleged offender. The Committee shall then consider their verdict and shall determine what action to take, if any. Their decision shall be communicated in writing to the alleged offender within 48 hours of the conclusion of the hearing, and shall set out the details of the offence, the decision of the Committee and the action to be taken. In addition, the alleged offender shall be informed of his/her right to appeal to the Club in General Meeting, together with an explanation of the Appeal Procedure.

The minutes of both these hearings shall be recorded in writing.

18. APPEAL PROCEDURE

If a request is made for an Appeal Hearing, it shall be made within 14 days of receipt by the offender of the Committee's verdict. It shall be made in writing to the Club Secretary, and should include the basis for the request, such as new evidence/information, or unreasonable action by the Committee. If the appeal is made correctly, the committee shall call an Extraordinary General Meeting to hear the appeal, within 14 days of receipt of the notice of appeal. The quorum for such a meeting shall be as for an Annual General Meeting.

At the Appeal Hearing the offender shall be asked to put forward his/her case, and shall have the right to be represented and to introduce witnesses and character references. The Committee's case shall also be put to the meeting. When all the evidence has been heard, the members shall have the option of upholding the Committee's decision or of changing it in the light of the evidence submitted to their meeting. Their decision shall be minuted in writing and communicated to the offender, and shall be binding.

19. PUBLICATION OF CONSTITUTION AND RULES

The Constitution and Rules of the Club shall be published in the Club Handbook, which shall be available to all members.

Coaching

A beginner's course is available to all new bowlers who join the Club.

The course is free and will be over 2-4 one hour sessions depending on numbers and ability.

Mostly, these will be held on Saturday mornings but some other times may be available.

Coaching workshops will be available during the season.
