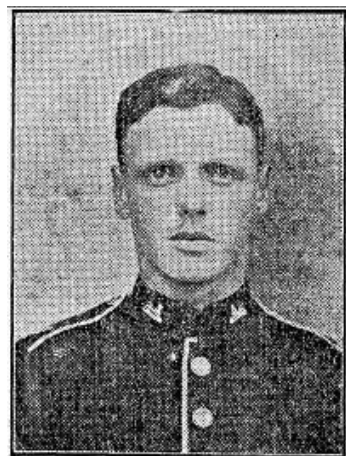

WOUNDED IN THE PERSIAN GULF.

Mr. and Mrs. Walter Crowhurst, Rose Cottage, Upper Halling, have received information from the War Office to the effect that their son, Bertie Walter Crowhurst, No. 8898, 2nd Battalion Dorset Regiment, was wounded in action on November 22nd, 1915, but whether dangerously, severely, or slightly is not stated. He joined the Dorset Regiment on March 1th, 1909, and proceeded with his regiment to India in 1912. On the outbreak of war he was drafted with the 16th Infantry Brigade, 1th Poona Division, Indian Expeditionary Force, to the seat of war at the Persian Gulf, where he was wounded as stated. He is 25 years of age.
