	<p>PARISH COUNCIL REPRESENTATION</p> <p>Sellafield now an upper tier COMAH site because of nitric acid. Off site emergency arrangements are being updated for both Nuclear and Chemical emergencies and each category will have its own emergency planning zone. It will move to a single siren. New household leaflet being prepared for houses within 6km of site.</p> <p>SL still trying to get CBC to approve their transport plan. They will start to bus people from Yottenfews again from 19/7 so we should be alert for people starting to park in unapproved places. About 6000 on site now going up to 6300 soon but “agile working” will limit numbers on site. Still working on train station improvements.</p> <p>SL looking for a new Very Low Level waste disposal site (CLESA). Will decide over next couple of years. Currently favour using an area (CO32) off site just south of Lady Wood. PC’s pushed back that not enough engagement with them taken place.</p> <p>CALC Executive – Meeting mainly concerned with GDF. Input from Dave Savage (Millom) on their meeting with GDF Chairman etc, “Millom without” PC critical of site selection process and lack of real engagement to date we echoed the comments on poor engagement with PCs in general.</p>																	

	Government will announce their favoured option for local Government reorganisation by mid July (post meeting Note: they have decided on unitary authorities Carlisle/Allerdale/Copeland and Eden/South Lakeland/Barrow).
