

# Current Vacancies

## Who can apply?

You must be:

- At least 18 years old
- A British citizen, or a citizen of the Commonwealth or European Union
- Meet at least one of the following criteria:
  - Registered as a local government elector for the parish
  - Have lived, worked, or owned property in the parish (or within 3 miles) for at least 12 months

## What does the role involve?

- Attending monthly council meetings
- Participating in decision-making on local issues
- Engaging with residents and local organisations
- Upholding high standards of conduct and public service

No prior experience is required training and support will be provided.
