Bishopstoke Parish Council Election 2016 Bishopstoke Parish Council was re-established in 1996, and the election on 5th May will be the 6th since then. 14 Councillors are due to be elected across the Parish. It is divided into 3 wards to fit in with the Borough and County boundaries. There are 6 councillors for Bishopstoke East, 4 councillors for Bishopstoke Central and 4 councillors for Bishopstoke North-West. The Parish Council is now running allotments, the cemetery, bus shelters, play areas and open spaces, so there's lots to do!. Emerging Local Plan 2011-2036 - Issues & Option Document Consultation

The recent big talking point in Bishopstoke has been the Issues and Options document - just part of the work the Borough has been doing to put a Local Plan in place. This document shows the Borough's thinking on different ways to meet housing and employment need in the area in the next 20 years. (If some of the options were to be adopted, they would vastly increase the size of Bishopstoke and prove very unpopular with many residents). Organisations and individuals were invited to make their views known to the Borough Council by 17th February. The Parish Council organised a Community Meeting to ensure that when the Parish Council completed the Consultation document we truly represented the views of the people of Bishopstoke. The lively meeting was attended by more than 100 people. Based on views expressed and discussion amongst Parish Councillors at the February Finance meeting, we completed the consultation. Our response can be found on the Bishopstoke PC website.

And we're asking you.....

To join with us in creating a **Neighbourhood Plan**, tailored to the needs and wishes of Bishopstoke people. We're the first Parish in Eastleigh Borough to do this. It was standing room only at the Community meeting held to start this off on Friday 11th March, with plenty of people signing up to get involved.
